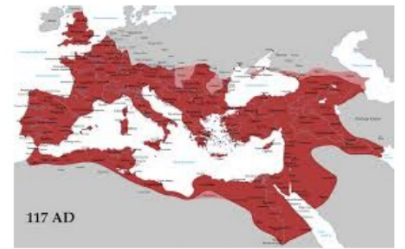

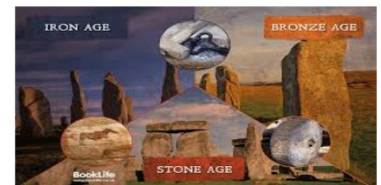

## Success criteria for a newspaper report

### Language

- Third person
- Past tense
- Quotes written as direct speech
- Embedded clauses

### Layout

- Name of newspaper
- Interesting headline
- Introduction paragraph (5 W's)
- Facts about events
- Pictures with captions
- Conclusion

### Embedded clauses:

- adds extra information to the main clause.
- usually placed after the subject of the sentence.
- separate the embedded clause from the main clause with a pair of commas.
- embedded clauses don't contain a relative pronoun.

## **Where are we going with our writing?**

Name of newspaper and headline

Introduction (who, what, when, where, why)

Main events (facts not opinions)

Eyewitness accounts (direct speech)

Conclusion (what might happen next)

**T.S.** During the afternoon of 24th August 61AD, a great commotion was heard throughout the roads of Norfolk. Boudicca, leader of the Iceni tribe, decided to lead a battle against the Romans.

- 1) Who - Boudicca, Iceni Tribe
- 2) When - afternoon, 3pm
- 3) Where - 30km from the aqueduct in Chirk, Norfolk

**C.S.** It is believed that Boudicca, a Celtic warrior queen, was seeking revenge against the Romans.

#### **Introduction (5 W's)**

- Who - Boudicca, Iceni
- What - revolt, battle
- When - 61AD
- Where - Norfolk, England
- Why - Romans wanted to take over land after death of Prasutagus

#### **Main events**

- Prasutagus died, Boudicca becomes leader of Iceni
- Romans want to take over land
- Boudicca revolts
- Battle (over 100,000 men)
