word before adding -ility

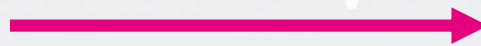
Can you spot the word that doesn't fit in this table?

'curiosity' is an exception to the rule, so you just need to learn it!

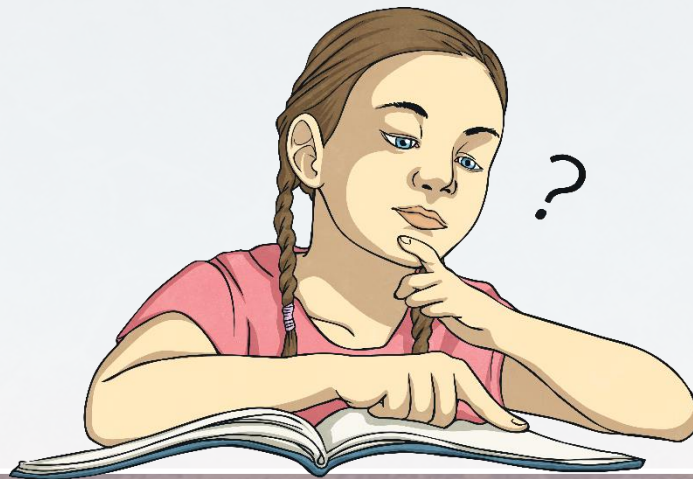
