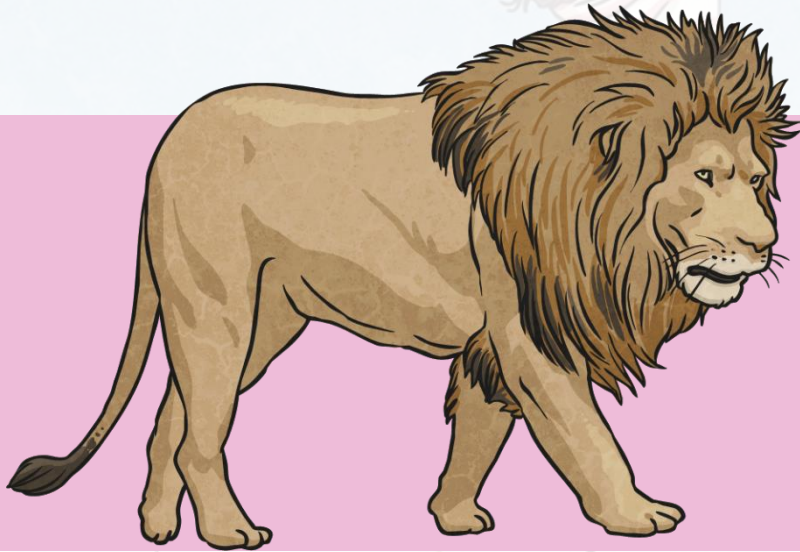


For this week's spellings, we are looking at words that are created by adding the suffix -ness.

It is a **noun** that has been created by adding -ness to an adjective.

Many words (but not all) that end in the suffix -ness are a special type of noun called an 'abstract noun'.

Abstract nouns describe a state of mind, a feeling, a quality or a characteristic that you cannot physically see.
